These scholarships recognize recipients for their efforts and hard work as both leaders and scholars on their campus, in their community and in their personal lives.

The Sigma Pi Educational Foundation is pleased to offer a variety of scholarships ranging from \$250 - \$1,000 toward educational expenses. The generous contributions of alumni and friends to the various funds and the unrestricted Annual Fund make these awards possible.

All applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

The Scholarship Committee evaluates each applicant based on:

- Sigma Pi Leadership and Honors
- Campus and Community Involvement and Employment
- Academic Achievement (cumulative GPA)
- Quality of the applicant's essay
- Financial need
- Substance of Chapter Director, Professors' and/or alumni recommendations

Your application will only be considered if it contains all of the following:

- Completed answers to all applicable questions in the space provided.
- A cover letter describing up to three activities from the last year in which you demonstrated leadership-in-action. Explain in detail what you did, what was accomplished and how your action made a difference. The letter must not exceed two pages.
- Current transcript from your college or university.
- Two letters of recommendation. The letters must be written by alumni and/or individuals who can attest to the activities described in your cover letter.

**Please be sure to proofread your entire application to avoid mistakes and pay close attention to proper spelling, grammar, punctuation and capitalization.**

Please do not staple or bind your application. Use a paper clip to secure your application.
