PROPOSAL DEVELOPMENT

- Most participants will be more advanced than a newly initiated member so presentation should be beyond the basic information.
- The information provided will be utilized when the attendees return to their Chapters so provide resources, handouts, and checklists.
- Presentations should be interactive as participants want to talk to one another in small groups and are often able to share ideas and learn a lot from others in these discussions.
- Participants may include alumni so please make sure any topic you present on include information for alumni participants.
- Participants want information and not icebreakers.

LOGISTICS

Presenters who are selected will be registered for the conference. All materials (handouts, Powerpoint presentations, etc.) should be also available for participants after Sigma Pi University. They may be placed in MySigmaPi for all members.

Presenters will be given the opportunity to stay on the Middle Tennessee State University campus. If a presenter wishes to stay at a local hotel, the Executive Office will direct you to the various hotels in the area; however, paying for the hotel will fall to the presenter. All meals will be on the campus.
