POSITION SUMMARY

Chapter Management Associates foster strong relationships with chapter leaders, alumni volunteers, and campus administrators at colleges and universities across North America. These individuals provide support and development to existing chapters and newly established colonies by focusing on development of strong chapter operations in areas such as recruitment, membership education, and risk management. Chapter Management Associates serve as the primary liaison between individual chapters and the Fraternity's Executive Office, and are responsible for the promotion of the values of Sigma Pi Fraternity. This position reports to the Director of Chapter Management.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Visits Sigma Pi undergraduate chapters and colonies to meet with individual leaders, volunteers, and administrators to ensure their continued success
- Provides training and leads discussions for the continuing development of chapters on topics including, but not limited to, recruitment, membership education, health and safety, scholarship, chapter management, etc.
- Completes reports and maintains communication with each chapter and colony following visits
- Assists in colony development efforts, including leading new officer and advisor trainings
- When not traveling, Chapter Management Associates assist in the creation and revision of Sigma Pi programs and resources
- Perform other duties as assigned

- History of work experience, including internships/externships, required
- Fraternity knowledge and experience required, Sigma Pi membership strongly preferred
