

Sigma Pi Fast Facts

OVERVIEW

Sigma Pi Fraternity is a social, men's fraternity founded in 1897 at Vincennes University in Vincennes, IN originally as a men's literary society. Sigma Pi Fraternity was also the first fraternity founded west of the Ohio River. As a founding member of the NIC, Sigma Pi became an international organization in 1984.

EXECUTIVE OFFICE STAFF

Sigma Pi is located in Nashville, Tennessee. All reports and membership registration can be completed via the website. The Executive Office tracks chapter/colony efficiency, finances, membership, and conducts officer trainings, and workshops on site. The Strategic Growth Department is composed of a Director of Strategic Growth and Assistant Director of Strategic Growth - Colony Success.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAMMING

Tony Siress Leadership Summit: The Fraternity's off-Convocation-year summer conference. The focus of this conference is to provide personal and professional development to our membership. Topics will revolve around critical thinking, conflict management, interpersonal development, stress management, strengths-based thinking, group communication, and navigating organizational dynamics.

Mid-Year Leadership Conference: A leadership conference held each January for newly-elected chapter officers, Chapter/Colony Directors and Province Archons. The focus of the conference is to instruct the new officers on their roles and responsibilities as chapter leaders.

Province Workshops: Held annually in each region by our Province Archons and Alumni Volunteers for chapters and colonies in there area.

Online resources: Sigma Pi provides the Study Guide for Academic Success, Foundation for Membership and Officer Manuals for each chapter/colony within the online resource center. Sigma Pi Fraternity is one of twenty other international/national fraternities & sororities to sponsor 1-888-NOT-HAZE as part of the ongoing attempt to end hazing on college campuses across North America.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Sigma Pi is the only Fraternal organization in North America with a service project giving back to the host institutions through the ACE Project™ (Altruistic Campus Experience). The Altruistic Campus Experience encourages members to develop pride and respect for the place that they will one day call their alma mater. Each chapter is encouraged to conduct a service event that is designed to benefit their campus. This requires the men of Sigma Pi to find an "unmet need" in the campus community.



EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

Each year the Sigma Pi Educational Foundation gives away nearly \$100,000 to chapter and colony members in the form of leadership and academic scholarships & grants. Members have the opportunity to become part of the Sigma Pi All-Collegiate Team.

EXPANSION/COLONY SUPPORT

The Strategic Growth Department is involved in a four to six week long recruitment visit on campus. One staff member, serving as the project manager, will spend between 10-12 weeks on campus in the initial expansion semester and up to six weeks the following semester on campus thoroughly training members to follow the Four Degrees to Chartering.

ALUMNI SUPPORT

Alumni Advisory Board is compiled prior to the first expansion visit and is composed of: Colony Director, Alumni Comptroller, Recruitment Advisor, New Member Education/Risk Management Advisor, Alumni Relations Advisor, Faculty Advisor and Housing Director. Housing is acquired through a local housing corporation.
