

COVID-19 Update

Brothers, Advisors, and Volunteers -

Since we last messaged you on March 11, we have seen an increase in the number of campuses who have moved to online class formats, extended spring break, or taken other measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. As of writing this, 100% of Sigma Pi chapters and colonies are affected by these disruptions in campus life.

First, we continue to implore all members to adhere to necessary precautions identified by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and to maintain regular contact with your educational institution as it relates to any precautionary measures or policies they are considering. Of equal importance is staying apprised of your local government for any additional measures they may be putting in place.

During this time, I find myself reflecting on the topic of disruption. Disruption is a constant in business and life, and how we handle it will define us as humans and leaders. Currently, as we are all aware, we are in a global disruption of an unprecedented nature. This is creating panic and fear, and is impacting the way of life we have grown accustomed to. However, business and life are still moving, but in a different manner, which in many cases is virtual.

From a leadership position, it is important to use this time to assess the situation, develop an appropriate plan and take the necessary action now, to not just focus on today, but to prepare for the future, when this is behind us. As an example, here at the Executive Office, we too have had to rethink our business model to overcome this disruption:

- We have moved all of our employees to working remotel
- During this time, staff will be available for phone and/or virtual consultation and will be available to provide advice on moving your new member program online
- · We have suspended all non-essential business travel until April 4th, and will reassess this as more information becomes available
- · Currently, we have postponed the opening of Convocation registration until April 1

Third, we should each remember our Mission "to inspire, promote and support the lifelong development of our brothers." This is a trying time for everyone, and staying focused as leaders is imperative. At Sigma Pi, we do not tolerate profiling against those who are perceived to carry COVID-19. As stated before, we should embrace this global pandemic as an opportunity to foster community and compassion to those around us.

Lastly, 170 new members still need to complete the required pledge steps. They cannot be submitted on an initiation report until these have been completed. Members who are not properly reported are not covered under the Sigma Pi insurance program including the Membership Accidental Protection Program. It is imperative that these members are properly reported as soon as possible to ensure coverage.

As always, please do not hesitate to reach out to our Executive Office staff. Be safe, wash your hands, and follow the guidelines set forth by the CDC to limit the spread of COVID-19.
