Tightrope Health and Safety Module

As of March 24, 2020 there are 443 undergraduate members who still need to complete the Tightrope Module. The first deadline, originally established as of March 11th, has been moved to April 15, 2020. To accommodate members during this unprecedented time the second and third deadline for completion have also been moved to May 15, 2020 and June 15, 2020.

Halting Shipments

Every spring we stop shipping pledge/initiate materials after April 30, 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic this year, we have now stopped all shipments until schools return to session in the fall.

Accounts Receivable and Pledge/Initiate Reporting

We understand that your chapter may be experiencing issues with your collections and it is impacting the chapters ability to submit payment on invoices. If you are experiencing difficulty, please discuss with your point of contact at the Executive Office, so we can provide options. Also note, outside of new member and initiation fees, the final invoice from Sigma Pi was sent on March 3, 2020. There are no new invoices, other than membership or failure to complete Tightrope fines, that will be sent until October 1, 2020. Reminders on outstanding invoices will still be sent until paid.

Per our email on March 11, 2020 all new member programs are expected to be completed, and new member forms and fees to be submitted by March 31, 2020. We understand several chapters have moved to virtual education to complete the program, and thank you for being cognizant of other people's health and safety. Your chapter can also let your point of contact at the Executive Office know when you'll be hosting your Golden Quest initiation ceremony this fall, and we'll work with you to ensure that all new member materials arrive prior to the ceremony. This is contingent on all new member fees being paid and that no initiate has outstanding Tightrope modules to complete.
